Lloyd Evans, ChipsAway Chief Executive and Martin Smith, Franchise Director, have completed the Three Peaks Challenge in order to raise over £2,000 for the Ataxia-Telangiectasia Society.

The Three Peaks Challenge is a gruelling event which involves climbing the highest mountains in England, Scotland and Wales (Scafell Pike, Ben Nevis and Snowdon respectively) all within 24 hours.

The good news is, Lloyd and his team successfully completed the task, reaching the bottom of Snowdon in just under 22 hours.

Lloyd explains: "This charity has particular significance to me as my daughter's friend and her younger brother both have the disease. Ataxia-Telangiectasia (A-T) is a rare, neurodegenerative, inherited disease which affects many parts of the body and causes severe disability.

I am thrilled that we have managed to raise such a fantastic amount of money for such an important charity."
